### **Teacher requirements and qualifications**

- Strong oral and written communication skills in English
- Ability to identify with American Muslim students of different age groups
- Ability to create relevant lesson plans and implement different teaching styles that will increase student interest and motivation
- Ability to manage a classroom of up to 25 students
- Possess or currently seeking a Bachelor's degree in any discipline
- Teaching experience in the subject is preferred

### **Additional requirements for Quran teachers**

- Possess permission (Ijaza) to teach Quran.
- Ability to teach Quran with proper tajweed and pronunciation
- Native Arabic Language speaker
- Strong English communications skills are required to teach the meanings of the verses being taught and break them down into simple English

### **Time commitment**

- Teachers P/T Approximately 7 hours per week
- 5 hours on Sundays, plus 2 hours/week of lesson preparation
